#### Day I

**Anchorage:** Fly into Alaska's largest city and meet your Alaska guide before transferring to your hotel.

#### Day 2

Anchorage/Seward: Enjoy a brief city tour of Anchorage, including the historic downtown district, prior to visiting the Anchorage Museum, a world-class museum which seeks to preserve, exhibit and interpret the art and history of Alaska. Board a deluxe motorcoach for Seward, looking out for Dall sheep high up in the rocky cliffs, as well as moose, bears and eagles.

#### Day 3

Explore the face of a glacier and watch for seals, sea lions, sea otters, whales, walrus, bears, eagles and puffins.

#### Day 4

Denali National Park: Board the motorcoach for a journey north on the scenic Parks Highway, making several stops along the way. Watch for a glimpse of the majestic Denali as well as all varieties of wildlife as you travel. In the evening, enjoy dinner at the Denali Dinner Theater.

### Day 5

Denali National Park: Travel deep into Denali National Park on a narrated, 6-8 hour Tundra Wilderness Tour in search of bear, moose, caribou and Dall sheep while gaining insight into the wildlife and flora of this spectacular region. In the afternoon, explore this pristine area at your leisure by either participating in a complimentary park service activity or optional tour such as mild or wild river rafting, flightseeing, a jetboat safari on the Nenana River or a visit to an Iditarod champion's award-winning dog kennel.

### Day 6

Talkeetna: In the morning, board a Deluxe Dome Railcar for a day trip to Talkeetna, which began as a trading post when gold was first discovered in the Susitna River. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure in this quaint town or participate in an optional activity such as flightseeing, hiking or a jetboat adventure.
