Day 1

Las Vegas: Arrive in the "Entertainment Capital of the World" and transfer to your hotel. Your Tour Director will greet you, then the rest of the day is yours to explore the city on your own.

Day 2

Route 66/Grand Canyon: Travel past Lake Mead and Hoover Dam to Kingman, Arizona, and a tour of the Route 66 Museum, which highlights the glory days of cross-country automobile travel. After, visit one of the "Seven Natural Wonders of the World" – Grand Canyon National Park. Take in its breathtaking beauty at all the best viewpoints along the South Rim.

Day 3

Navajo Nation/Monument Valley:

Take a last look at the Grand Canyon In the morning before traveling to the Navajo Nation Museum, where you will learn about Navajo history, culture and art. Continue on to Monument Valley and board a four-wheel drive vehicle for a scenic tour of the valley, the location for scores of famous western films, TV programs and commercials. Then, experience an evening of Navajo culture, food and entertainment.

Day 4

Arches National Park: Travel north to learn all about the Anasazi Indians and their history at Edge of the Cedars Museum.

Next, visit Moab and nearby Arches National Park — site of the highest concentration of natural arches in the world, with more than 2,000 named arches. In the evening, take a Sunset Jetboat Ride on the mighty Colorado River through spectacular red rock canyons, followed by a delicious barbeque dinner served on the riverbank.

Day 5

Dead Horse Point State Park & Capitol Reef National Park: Travel to Dead Horse Point State Park for spectacular views of Canyonlands National Park and the mighty Colorado River 2,000 feet below. Next, arrive at Capitol Reef National Park for a picnic lunch under towering cottonwood trees. Later, drive over Boulder Mountain on your way to the town of Boulder for touring of Anasazi State Park Museum with its ancient Indian ruins. Finally, travel through Grand Staircase—Escalante National Monument with its dramatic cliffs, high mesas and deep canyons in multi-hued colors.

Bryce Canyon/Zion national parks: Travel to Bryce Canyon National Park and explore the main viewpoints while learning more about the park in the visitor's center. Then, take a short drive to see Utah's oldest national park, Zion National Park, featuring 2,000-foot high freestanding towers of rock. After lunch, explore Zion Canyon, a brilliant green canyon set against sheer red cliffs with waterfalls fanning out from the rocks. In the evening, enjoy a Farewell Dinner at your hotel.

Day 7

Las Vegas: In the morning, travel across the Nevada desert and return to Las Vegas Airport for your departure home. Be sure to schedule your flight <u>after</u> 12 noon local time.
