AAA TRAVEL EXCLUSIVE COLORADO TRAIN ADVENTURE TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1

Denver/Colorado Springs: Arrive in Denver (by 1 pm), meet your Tour Director, then travel by motorcoach to Colorado Springs and tour the U.S. Air Force Academy, famous for its architecturally unique chapel. Enjoy a group welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 2

Pikes Peak Country: Take a ride on the Pikes
Peak Cog Railway to the top of Pikes Peak, 12,110
ft. above sea level. Continue to the Garden of the
Gods Trading Post for lunch and time to shop.
Later, tour the Garden of the Gods, known for its
magnificent red sandstone rock formations. Later,
gather for an evening of western hospitality at a
local restaurant.

Day 3

Royal Gorge/Alamosa: Board the Royal Gorge Route Railroad for a vintage train ride along the legendary Arkansas River deep within the gorge. Next, travel to the historic rail town of Salida for a delicious homestyle lunch. In the afternoon, visit Great Sand Dunes National Park for sightseeing before arriving in Alamosa.

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Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railway: Board the 1880 narrow gauge Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad, once called "the most awesomely spectacular example of mountain railroading in North America." Next, travel by motorcoach to the Old West mining town of Durango for a two-night stay.

Day 5

Mesa Verde National Park: Explore the cliff dwellings of Mesa Verde National Park where the mysterious Anasazi once lived almost 1,000 years ago. A local expert will guide you through the most famous ruin sites. Return to Durango with the rest of the day free to explore this fun western town on your own.

Day

Durango/Silverton: Ride the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad, one of the last such railroads operating in the United States, through the Colorado Rockies. Next, board a motorcoach for a scenic drive north to Grand Junction. In the evening, visit the fantastic monoliths of Colorado National Monument.

Day 7

Grand Junction/Denver: Travel east through the Heart of the Rockies, enjoying vistas of rugged canyons, pristine wilderness and deep gorges. Cross the Continental Divide at Loveland Pass before stopping at the Colorado Railroad Museum in Golden. In the evening, join fellow passengers for a farewell dinner.

Day 8

Denver: Transfer to the airport in the morning for your journey home.
