Day 1

Anchorage: Fly into Alaska's largest city and transfer to your hotel.

Day 2

Valdez: Board a deluxe motorcoach and drive through Matanuska-Susitna Valley, where vegetables grow to world-record size in the 24-hour daylight. Stop by Worthington Glacier for a close-up look. Late afternoon, arrive in Valdez for a two-night stay, with a welcome reception to follow.

Day 3

Prince William Sound: Spend the morning in Valdez with included entrance to the Valdez Museum. In the afternoon, board a glacier and wildlife cruise and travel through majestic Prince William Sound. Explore the three-mile face of Columbia Glacier while watching seals, sea lions, otters, whales and puffins.

Day 4

Fairbanks: Board the motorcoach for a journey north to Fairbanks, the Golden Heart City. The route takes you along Wrangell-St. Elias National Park, the largest national park in the U.S., as well as the Trans-Alaska Pipeline. Upon arrival, you'll check-in for a two-night stay.

Day 5

Chena River: Learn how the gold rush affected Alaska's interior on a sightseeing tour with included visit to the Museum of the North. Later, shop, walk or dine on your own in the downtown area, then cruise the Chena River aboard a sternwheeler followed by an authentic and savory salmon bake.

Day 6

Denali National Park: Travel south to Denali National Park and spend the afternoon exploring this pristine area with a complimentary park service activity or optional tour. Enjoy a mild or wild river rafting, flightseeing, a jet boat safari, or a visit to an Iditarod champion's dog kennel. At night, enjoy dinner at the Denali Dinner Theatre.

Day 7

Denali National Park: Take a narrated, 6-8 hour Tundra Wilderness Tour deep into Denali National Park, home to Denali, North America's tallest mountain. Throughout the tour, be on the lookout for bear, moose, caribou and Dall sheep roaming the varied terrain.

Day 8

Alaska Railroad: After a morning of exploring Talkeetna, board deluxe dome railcars for the trip back to Anchorage. Along the way, search for black bears gathering on the banks of the Susitna River, while admiring the breathtaking scenery.

Day 9

Anchorage: Enjoy a brief city tour of Anchorage, including its historic downtown district. Later, visit the Alaska Native Heritage Center, followed by a closing night dinner.

Day 10

Anchorage: After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your departing flight home.
