Day 1

Seattle: Arrive at Seattle Airport before 4 pm and take a shuttle to the hotel where you will meet your tour director. In the evening, join your group for a Welcome Dinner.

Day 2

Seattle: In the morning, experience the Future of Flight Aviation Center & Boeing Tour. Look as the world's largest jets are assembled by volume in the world's largest building. Return to Seattle and stop at the Pike Place Market, the oldest continuously operating market in the U.S., where you can buy anything from an old clock to an octopus. In the afternoon, take a harbor cruise and visit Seattle's soaring Space Needle. Then, wander through Chihuly Garden & Glass, home to world-famous Northwest glass artist Dale Chihuly. Dinner is at your leisure.

Day 3

Mt. St. Helens/Seaside: Travel to the Mt. St. Helens Visitor's Center where you can witness the volcano's awesome destructive power along with the incredible recovery that has occurred. Continue traveling the

Pacific Coast to Oregon with scenic stops along the way. In the afternoon, stop for a tour of Fort Clatsop National Historical Park, the site where the 33-member Lewis and Clark Expedition wintered from 1805 to 1806. Travel Highway 101 with its spectacular views of the Oregon Coast on your way to Seaside, Oregon's first resort town, where you'll overnight.

Day 4

Oregon Coast: In the morning, travel to Tillamook, Oregon's leading dairy-producing region and home to the Tillamook Cheese Factory, where you'll watch cheese being made. After, head to Lincoln City for a Pacific Northwest culinary demonstration and lunch at the Culinary Center, then arrive in Newport for a tour of the Oregon Coast Aquarium, one of Oregon's top tourist attractions.

Day 5

Portland: Head down the coast to the Oregon Dunes Recreation Area for an exciting, 1-hour dune buggy ride. Next, travel inland to Eugene and then on to Portland and visit the International Rose Test Garden, the oldest

official, continuously operated public rose test garden in the U.S. Later, enjoy some free time to explore downtown Portland.

Day 6

Columbia River Gorge: Travel east through the Columbia River Gorge via the inside scenic route on your way to Multnomah Falls, the largest of a series of 11 waterfalls in the area, and one of the four highest in the U.S. Next, enjoy a self-guided tour of Bonneville Dam before making your way to Timberline Lodge, nestled on the slopes of Mt. Hood, where you'll experience spectacular mountaintop views.

Day 7

Portland: After breakfast, transfer to Portland Airport for your flight home.
