We - Oct 17

Depart Tampa: Depart from Tampa International Airport on your overnight flight to Arusha, Tanzania.

Th = Oct 18

Arusha, Tanzania: Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer to the Arusha Hotel, located amidst its own private tropical garden and home to many of east Africa's rich birdlife.

Fr = Oct 19

Lake Manyara: After breakfast, journey to Lake Manyara National Park for an afternoon game drive which, apart from its abundant bird and animal life, is known for its tree-climbing lions. Overnight at Lake Manyara Serena Lodge, offering panoramic views across the volcano-studded floor of the Great Rift Valley and wildlife sightings that may include monkey, zebra, hippo, giraffe, elephant and thousands of sugar-pink Lesser Flamingos.

Sa • Oct 20

Su & Mo = Oct 21-22

Central Serengeti: Spend the next two days thrilling to morning and afternoon game drives within Serengeti National Park. Set out in a private safari vehicle with an experienced driver and expert safari guide. Ngorongoro Conservation Area: After breakfast, transfer to the local airstrip for your included flight to Manyara. Arrive at Ngorongoro Conservation

Ngorongoro Crater: Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast before departing with picnic lunch boxes to Ngorongoro Crater, the largest intact caldera in the world.
