**Chuck Prophet & Mission Express: A WMNF** 

favorite live artist for 17 years, Chuck brings to life a vivid parade of razor-edged one-liners camouflaged in a slack-jawed drawl and songs about heartbreak and everyman heroism, drenched in the twisted lines of rude Telecaster.

The Bright Light Social Hour: The band from Austin has gained attention with their incendiary live performances and innovative vision of rock and roll, melding southern rock, hard-dance, psychedelic blues and deep-soul. Their single "Tear Down That Wall" has received lots of WMNF airplay.

Nikki Hill and Band: Buoyed by her band's roaring boogie that's equal parts Staple Singers and AC/DC, Nikki exudes a self-assured swagger as her fiery rasp preaches the rock & roll gospel. The band tours the globe relentlessly, stunning audiences with their muscular sound.
